There will be termly letters to notify you of the dates and topics of the assessments. Your child/ward will receive his/her report book at the end of Term 2 and Term 4.
- 4. Do note that if a student is absent for any assessment, he/she is required to **submit a valid medical certificate/official document** to the form teacher.
- 5. Your child's/ward's learning progress will be shared with you during the Parent Teacher Meetings in the course of the year. More details about the Parent Teacher Meetings will be provided at a later date.
- 6. It is important to encourage your child/ward to focus on learning and not on grades. Do affirm and encourage your child's/ward's effort and progress and help him/her cultivate good study habits such as completing assignments on time. We hope you will use the information provided to partner us in guiding your child/ward towards better progress in his/her learning.
