- 5. Your child's/ward's learning progress will be shared with you during the Parent Teacher Meetings in the course of the year. More details about the Parent Teacher Meetings will be provided at a later date.

Do affirm and encourage your child's/ward's effort and progress and help him/her cultivate good study habits such as completing assignments on time. We hope you will use the information provided to partner us in guiding your child/ward towards better progress in his/her learning.
