What is Microsoft Office 365 ProPlus?



Office 365 ProPlus is a suite of productivity tools (including full versions of Excel, PowerPoint & Word) that is installed on your personal desktop, laptop or mobile devices and PLD.

Personal learning Device(PLD) is a computing device that every secondary student has. Primary school students do not have PLD.

As part of the MOE-Microsoft Student Use Benefits, students can use their MIMS (Student iCON) accounts to download Office Applications such as Excel, PowerPoint, Word etc.

This access is **free** for students whose parents have given their consent to use MOE's centrally provisioned digital tools.

Office.com online services (e.g. OneDrive, Teams etc.) are not available at this phase of deployment. More details will be shared at a later date when the services become available.

Which Office 365 ProPlus apps can you download?



Excel

Excel allows you to use worksheets to store and organize numbers and data in a table format by using formulas and functions.



Powerpoint

Powerpoint allows you to create presentations slides, add text, images, transitions and animations.



Word

Word allows you to create and format your document with themes and polish the words you type.

OneNote


OneNote allows you to take notes and store information such as text and images in a document.



Outlook

Outlook allows you to organise your emails, manage and share your calendar to schedule meetings.

Access (PC Only)

Access is a database management system which allows you to view and edit data. It is similar to Excel, but it is able to manage more data efficiently.



Publisher (PC Only)

Publisher allows you to create a wide variety of publications such as posters, business cards, calendars, newsletters and greeting cards.

Minimum Requirements (iOS and Android)

- iOS: Office for iPad® and iPhone® (including Outlook for iOS) is supported on the two most recent versions of iOS and iPadOS. When a new version of iOS or iPadOS is released, the Office Operating System requirement becomes the two most recent versions: the new version of iOS or iPadOS and the previous version.
- Android: Office for Android (including Outlook for Android) can be installed
 on tablets and phones running any of the supported versions of Android and
 have an ARM-based or Intel x86 processor. Starting on July 1, 2019, support
 will be limited to only the last four major versions of Android.

Step 1:

Go to 'https://aka.ms/office-install' on your browser.


Enter your MIMS ID (Student iCON email address) and click 'Next'.

password and click 'Sign in'




Step 3:

After download is completed, click on the OfficeSetup.exe file at the bottom of your browser and follow the instructions for installation.

Click on 'File' then 'Account'.





Download any Office app available on the App Store. (e.g. Word or PowerPoint. Refer to p. 8 for the list of iOS Office apps.)






Access & Activation for Mac

Enter your password and click 'Sign In'



Once the download has completed, open Finder, go to Downloads, and double-click Microsoft Office installer.pkg file. Follow instructions to complete the installation.







FAQ

Which Office 365 ProPlus apps can I download?

You would be entitled to access various apps such as **Word, Powerpoint** and **Excel.** Refer to p. 8 for the list of apps by device type.

Can I install Office 365 ProPlus apps on multiple devices?

You may download and install Office 365 ProPlus apps on up to 5 computers, 5 tablets and 5 mobile phones (including your PLD) at a time.

Can I install Office 365 ProPlus with my personal email account?

No. As the license is tagged to your MIMS (Student iCON) account, you are only allowed to sign in using your MIMS (Student iCON) account.

FAQ

If I have already installed Office 365 previously, would I still be able to install Office 365 ProPlus apps on my device?

If you are currently using Office 365 and would like to make use of the Office 365 ProPlus apps, **sign out of your previous account** and sign in again using your MIMS (Student iCON) account.

Are there any rules that I should follow?

- a. The license is tied to your MIMS (Student iCON) account
- b. Install it only on your personal devices (including PLD) that you use
- c. Do not share your MIMS (Student iCON) login details with others
- d. Do not use it for improper or illegal purposes

6 What happens when I leave school or graduate?

When you leave school or graduate, your MIMS (Student iCON) account will be terminated. Your Office 365 ProPlus apps will then be downgraded and you can only view and print files. You cannot edit or create new files.

What is the difference between Microsoft Office 365 ProPlus apps and Microsoft Office 365?

Microsoft Office 365 ProPlus apps refers to "offline" apps (e.g. Microsoft Word, Excel etc.) that can be downloaded and installed on devices like laptops and tablets.

Microsoft Office 365 refers to the full suite of services which include "offline" apps and online services* that can be accessed via office.com.

^{*} Note that online services are not available at this stage of deployment.
